PURPOSE:

To provide the best possible care to all patients in cardiac arrest and provide a safe working environment when working with potentially infectious patients.

POLICY

All Bloomfield Genoa City Fire & Rescue (BGCFR) members and employees shall maintain a current C.P.R. issued by the American Heart Association.

Members and employee who have had their card expire shall be placed on inactive duty until their card has been renewed.

New members and employees must have a C.P.R. card and exposure control training before he or she may respond to calls.

An exposure control seminar provided by BGCFR shall be attended and passed annually, prior to responding to incidents or calls.

Members or employees who fail to attend the annual seminar shall be given a reasonable grace period for make up. (Less than 30 days). If the seminar is not attended or made up the member or employee shall be placed on inactive duty until the seminar has been made up.
