Subject: Dress and work uniform standards

A. DRESS UNIFORM CLASS A DEPARTMENT ISSUED

1. Dark blue dress jacket (if issued)
2. Dark blue dress pants
3. Dark blue dress shirt with dark blue tie
4. White dress shirt with dark blue tie (Chief grade officers)
5. Black belt
6. Black shoes
7. Dress cap (if issued)

B. WORK UNIFORM CLASS B

1. Dark blue polo shirt (provided)
2. Dark blue work shirt
3. White work shirt (Chief grade officers)
4. Dark blue work pants
5. Comfortable black shoes

C. TRAINING UNIFORM CLASS C

1. Dark blue work shirt (provided) or Department approved T shirt
2. Blue jeans or dark blue pants in good condition
3. Comfortable black shoes

D. CLASS A UNIFORM SHIRT STANDARDS

1. Left shoulder – Department patch
2. Right shoulder – American Flag.
3. Collar brass – American flag or Officer Rank
4. Badge – located above left pocket

5. Name Tag – located above right pocket

E. CLASS A UNIFORMS MAY BE WORN TO, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING:

1. Funerals
2. Parades
3. Special Department Functions
4. Meetings
5. Fire Inspections

F. CLASS B UNIFORMS SHALL BE WORN AT, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING:

1. All Department practices (Fire, Squad and EMS).
2. Funerals
3. Parades
4. Special Department Functions
5. Meetings
6. Fire Inspection
7. Class B uniforms shall be worn at trainings if the cost of pants are subsidized by the Department.

Note: Class B uniform is to be worn at Funerals and Parades only when a Class A has not been issued.

Class B uniforms are to be worn while on duty shift, 3rd person or contract person. Officer in charge may let the member or employee wear a department approved T-shirt, sweatshirt (work shirt) or department approved jacket.

G. CLASS C UNIFORMS SHALL BE WORN AT TRAININGS ONLY.

Class C uniforms shall be worn at trainings.

H. ALL UNIFORMS, WHEN WORN, SHALL BE WORN IN AN APPROPRIATE MANNER IN ACCORDANCE WITH BLOOMFIELD GENOA CITY FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT POLICY

1. Shirt tucked in, buttons buttoned.
2. No clothing to be worn over the top of the uniform when in attendance of meetings and practices, when in doors.
3. All Department issued uniforms (including dark blue polo duty shirt) are to be worn only for department business. Uniforms are not for wearing out to dine, to the bar, etc.
4. Officers may take special circumstances in to consideration (i.e. weather conditions, hours on calls, other) and vary from this policy if deemed appropriate. All members and employees must appear neat and clean in uniform.
